For the rest of the calendar year, John Doyle has arranged for Lori Fudge – September; Marc Legere – October; November is open; Saint John String Quartet – December.

The guest speaker drew the winning ticket of David Flewelling, who won \$101.00, which he donated to the Boys and Girls Club.

Don LeBlanc introduced Bernard Cormier, who amused and entertained us with his mentalism abilities. Robert Taylor thanked Bernard, and presented him with our Anniversary mug.

President Ed presented Amy Shanks, Executive Director of the Boys and Girls Club, with a cheque for \$500.00.
