MINUTES FROM THE NOVEMBER MEETING

PROBUS Club of Saint John – November 15, 2023

<u>Call to 10:10 am</u> – Frank McCarey, President, opened the meeting. The meeting commenced with the singing of O Canada. There were thirty-five members in attendance. The meeting was held in the cafeteria area of the Villa Madonna. Chip Lawton introduced Tony Aziz as a guest. Members were advised that the December 13th, Christmas Dinner, meeting would be held at the Villa at a cost of \$35, with a choice of turkey or salmon. Members were advised that there would be no speaker for the December meeting and that the String Quartet would be on hand to provide some musical selections. Discussion was held by those in attendance regarding having future meetings at the Villa. It was indicated the cost of lunch would be \$20 (cash only). It was moved by **Gordon Dempsey** and seconded by **Don Mitchener** (Passed)

Frank advised that the planned Regional Meeting of Probus scheduled for November was postponed due to lack of response and would be rescheduled for a future date.

Ed Creaser, Treasurer was available to accept Membership fees (\$35) from those who wished to pay.

Paul Meier advised that as follow-up to the Membership survey completed recently it was indicated that Members would like to participate in more field trips. Paul indicated that the intent was to attempt to organize at least three per year. He indicated that he would be organizing one and was seeking volunteers to organize others.

She is a lifelong resident of Saint John and has served on several organizations and Boards, such as the Saint John Police Commission, the Canadian Bar Association, the American Bar Association and the Law Societies of NB and NS.

She was accompanied by her Assistant, **Mary Walker**, who circulated several information documents to the Members in attendance related to preparation of Estate Planning, including "Will" preparation and the Powers of Attorney process.

Mary-Elieen shared some details related to the various processes involved regarding Estate Planning, including the preparation of Wills and Powers of Attorney. She explained that there could be times that herself and other staff would meet off site with clients due to various circumstances and even virtually as needed. She explained that when dealing with Banks as part of the processes you must be aware of the requirements that must be met for things to run smoothly. Also, that things should be clearly laid out regarding the responsibilities of a person who is identified as an Executor for a Will or being identified as an individual who has Power of Attorney. She indicated further that an awareness of any Legislations in place governing these processes must be considered as well.

Following questions from Members, **Don Connolly** thanked Mary-Elieen for the informative presentation.


