Minutes from FEBRUARY 2024

PROBUS Club of Saint John - February 21, 2024

<u>Call to 10:05am</u> – Frank McCarey, President, opened the meeting. The meeting commenced with the singing of O Canada, led by Robert Taylor. There were 24 members in attendance. - The conversation aftert the meeting, about the tours, seems to have generated some enthusiam.





V.P. **Paul Meier** at the podium. Our new Banner is displayed to his left. It was well received.




